Accessing the link to 2021 ICSIoT Conference submission page

- Option 1.** Go to the Submission page by directly typing the following URL in your browser or click on it in this pdf directly <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICSIoT2021>

Or you are on the conference website, you can click on the [SUBMIT A PAPER](#) . You can find it as shown using the red arrow in in figure 2 and figure 3below.
After clicking on the submit button follow **Option 2**.

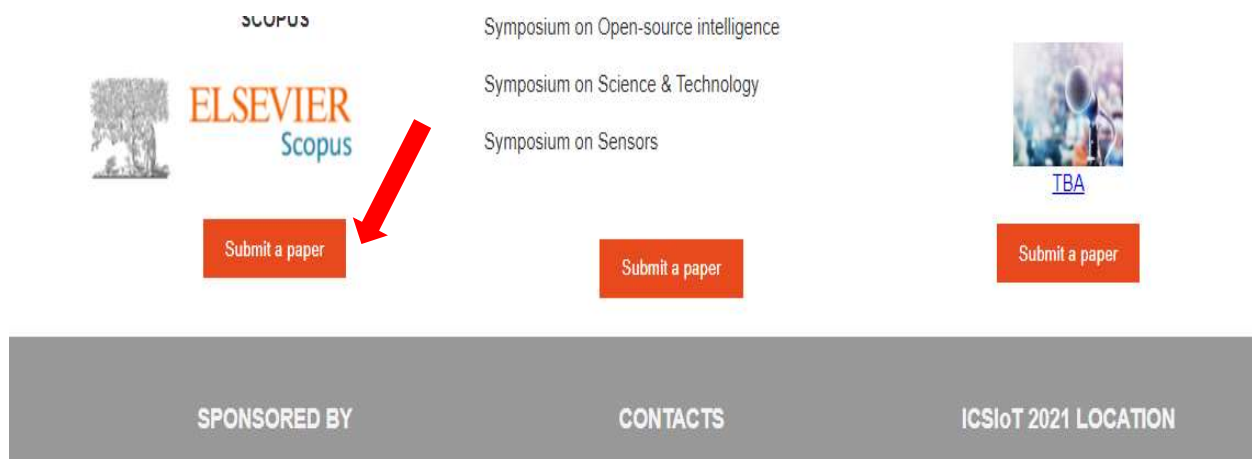


Figure 3: submission link on ICSIoT main site before the footer

NB: Those invited as reviewers via a mail will have to use option 3. to reset their password before login process.




Figure 4: Login page




Figure 5: Reset Password tab

Adding co-authors to the paper details

Option 8. Enter the email of the co-author and click on add as shown figure 13 below. If the co-author is a registered user, the details will be added automatically else If the co-author is not registered, the fields in the figure 14 will show for you to fill the fields with the details of the co-authors and submit. For the next step see **option 9**
